Description of the College and Community

Godalming College is a state funded, open access mixed Sixth Form College with over 2100 full time students aged 16 – 19 years old. We are situated in the suburban town of Godalming in the county of Surrey, 38 miles south west of London. We offer a wide ranging curriculum of A Level and BTEC courses. Students are given the opportunity to take four Level 3 courses in their first year and they may then continue with 3 subjects in their second year plus an additional study, such as an Extended Project (EPQ). Whilst students may opt for a 3+1 learning programme (eg 3 A Levels for 2 years and an additional AS in the first year), we tailor learning programmes to student need. Students on a linear A Level programme will not usually have taken an AS exam. Predicted grades are determined by assessing student performance in major benchmark assessments throughout their first year.

College Mission Statement: To provide high quality education and support for young people which develops the talents and promotes the aspirations of every student.

Admissions Policy: We are an open-access college and accept students from a wide variety of schools. 78% of our intake is from state funded comprehensive schools. We do not select by ability but students need to achieve a minimum of 5 A*- C (9-4) grades at GCSE to access A level and Level 3 BTEC courses. However, please note, some individual courses do have specific GCSE grade requirements.
