

Statutory Notice - Further and Higher Education Act 1992 Section 33N

This notice is given by the Corporation of Godalming College in accordance with the provisions of the Further and Higher Education Act 1992 as amended by the Apprenticeships, Skills, Children and Learning Act 2009 and the Education Act 2011 (the Act) of the proposal that the Corporation of Godalming College of Tuesley Lane, Godalming, Surrey GU71RS, be dissolved and the property, rights, assets and liabilities of Godalming College be transferred to a single academy trust to be established and known as Godalming College.

Dissolution of Godalming College is proposed at the request of the Corporation in order that Godalming College, a sixth form college, can convert to a 16-19 academy.

Godalming College provides post 16 education including a wide range of AS and A Level and BTEC qualifications, Level 2 qualifications including Mathematics and English GCSE courses. Godalming College currently has 2145 (2144 full time and 1 part time) 16-19 year old students on roll.

The date proposed for the dissolution of Godalming College as a Sixth Form College and the creation of Godalming College as a 16-19 academy is 1st September 2017 or as soon as possible thereafter subject to the appropriate permissions. All students currently attending Godalming College will continue their education as currently planned in the new 16-19 academy.
