Godalming College is a state funded, 16-19 Academy, with over 2000 full time students aged 16 -19 years old. We are situated in the suburban town of Godalming in the county of Surrey, 38 miles south west of London. We offer a wide ranging curriculum of A Level and BTEC courses and tailor study programmes to meet individual student needs, abilities and interests. Students are given the opportunity to take four Level 3 courses in their first year and they may then continue with 3 subjects in their second year, plus an additional study, such as an Extended Project (EPQ). Students on a linear A Level programme will not usually have taken an AS exam. Predicted grades are informed by assessing student performance in major benchmark assessments throughout their first year.

**Admissions Policy:** We are an open-access college and accept students from a wide variety of schools. 78% of our intake is from state funded comprehensive schools. We do not select by ability but students need to achieve a minimum of 5 GCSEs, grades 9-4, to access A level and Level 3 BTEC courses. However, please note, some individual courses have specific GCSE grade requirements.
