## Getting results

- Results will be available on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> August 2018 from 9.00 am on GOL.
- You will be able to access your results directly from Godalming Online. You will need to have your College login number and your password.
- You will be able to use the computers in the ILC to access your results from 9.00 am-11.00 am.
- Make sure that you **print a copy of your results and keep it in a safe place** - you may need your results in the future, but not be able to access GOL.

### Advice and Guidance:

- If you need advice about your results, Careers staff will be available in College between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup>, Friday 17<sup>th</sup> and Monday 20<sup>th</sup> August.

- **Log into UCAS Track** for confirmation decisions on <https://www.ucas.com/ucas/undergraduate/login> using your UCAS application number, username and password.
- **If a decision has not been made on Track and you missed the offer by a narrow margin**, it may be worth telephoning the Admissions Tutor for the course.
- **If you are rejected by your firm choice but meet the conditions of your insurance offer**, you will have a place confirmed on UCAS Track at that university.
- **If you no longer wish to go** to your confirmed place, you will need to phone the UCAS Customer Contact Centre on 0371 468 0 468 to discuss your options.
- **If you have not met the conditions** for your firm or insurance choice offer you will be eligible for Clearing (2018 entry).
