Applying to university through UCAS?

If Godalming College was your last place of full-time study, you may apply to UCAS through us, up to 3 years from the date you left college. We can only supply a reference for you if you apply to UCAS choosing the 'applying through a school or college' option and using our buzzword. For 2017 entry our buzzword will be *tuesley17*.

If you decide to apply to university for entry in autumn 2017 our relevant College deadlines will be:

- All applications for Oxbridge, Medics, Vets, Dentistry 19th September 2016 to meet the UCAS deadline of 15th October 2016.
- The last date for all other applications from ex-students 25th November 2016 to meet the UCAS deadline of 15th January 2017.
