### Priority Script Recalls for Review of Marking purposes

Students can request the return of marked examination scripts in order to make a decision on a review of marking. A fee per paper is payable. Please use the [WisePay](#) online payment system on Godalming Online to order your script. The **deadline is midday on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2018.**

### Non-Priority Script Recalls for revision

Students can order non-priority scripts for revision purposes on the [WisePay](#) online payments system at a cost per paper. **The deadline is midday on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> September.**

### Review of Marking

A review of marking can be requested on your return to College. The deadline date is midday **Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> September.** Students **MUST** first seek permission from a Director of Faculty who will issue a consent form to confirm that they support the application. This permission must then be brought to the Exams Office and an Exam Board consent form signed, as marks can go down as well as up. Fees vary between £45 and £60 per paper.

### Re-sitting modules

You should discuss any summer re-sits with your teachers in the first week of lessons. Re-sits must then be booked and paid for online by January—further instruction is given in the autumn term for this.

## Getting Results

- Your results for any BTEC, AS and A level courses will be available on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> August 2018 from 9am on GOL.
- Your results for any GCSE courses will be available on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2018 from 9am on GOL.
- You will be able to access your results directly from Godalming Online. You will need to have your College login number and your password.
- If you do not have access to the internet from home you may come to the ILC after 9am to use a computer.
- Make sure that you Print a copy of your results and keep it in a safe place – you may need the information for UCAS. Please see overleaf for more information.

## Advice and Guidance

- If you need advice about your results, senior staff will be available in College on the morning of Friday 17<sup>th</sup> August and each day from Monday 20<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August. Email us if necessary, but significant alterations to your programme as a consequence of AS results will be discussed on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September in the Senior Tutor Surgeries.
- The minimum study programme is three courses, two of which must be A levels. Please contact us if you are not sure as to whether you qualify to return.
- Please phone 01483 423526 first before coming into College to make sure that we can see you!
- An appointment may be made with a Senior Manager to discuss your concerns as appropriate.

**Monday 20<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> August** – Post Exams review interviews for students who have not achieved a pass grade in the AS subject that they wish to ‘bridge-up’

**Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> September** – Senior Tutor surgeries. You must attend if you have not confirmed your full-time course by the end of July. Appointments will be sent out in July.

**Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> September – 10am – 1pm** – all Oxbridge and early applicants to attend UCAS application session.

**Monday 10<sup>th</sup> September** – U6 lessons begin from 08.45am according to timetable.

**Monday 17<sup>th</sup> September** – College deadline for Oxbridge, Medicine, Dentistry and Vet applications.

**Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October** – Advisory deadline for other competitive university courses.

**Week commencing 29<sup>th</sup> October** – College deadline for all other UCAS applications.

**Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December** – College deadline for Art Foundation Applications.
