



Students celebrate A level success

Yet again Godalming has achieved an excellent set of exam results. Principal David Adelman says 'I am delighted that the hard-work and talent of our students and teaching staff has paid off with such rich rewards. The College has improved its A level pass rate to 99.4% and its A* - C grade to 82.2% and sustained an already high A*-B grade rate at 60.3%. In the context of the national picture in which A level standards are getting harder this is an exemplary performance. The BTEC performance is also excellent with 100% pass rate on all BTEC qualifications with 66.7% receiving a Distinction* or Distinction grade. We have nearly 800 students who have taken A level and BTEC qualifications this year and these results will enable our students to progress to higher education or employment where I'm sure their success will continue.'

Essex Court Chambers is widely acclaimed as one of the leading sets of barristers' chambers in England and each year hosts the National Mooting Competition for university students studying Law. It involved simulated court proceedings which is focused on the application of the law to a simulated case.



The national final was judged by Sir Franklin Berman QC and Claire Blanchard QC and panel chair Rt Hon Lord Justice Beatson.

Ex-student Jack Horlock and colleague Henry Perrins of the University of Sussex took part in the national finals held at the Royal Courts of Justice. They argued the fictitious legal appeal case, "Puff Limited v Making Tracks Consultants Limited" and were presented with the runner up prize of the Scarman Shield and offered a mini-pupillage with the Essex Court Chambers.
